











MANDATORY HEALTH STANDARDS

Effective immediately, Lakewood Montessori will observe the following Mandatory Health Standards:

PROCEDURE	DESCRIPTION
 <p>“Contactless” Drop-Off & Pick Up</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Designated drop-off and pick-up locations outside of building • Arrival times staggered to limit contact between families • Families and visitors not permitted to enter facility
 <p>Temperature/Health Screening</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children and staff temperature screened daily before entering facility & during lunch • Those with a fever of 100.4° (38.0°C) or above or exhibiting other signs of illness (cough, shortness of breath, recent loss of smell or taste, trouble breathing, persistent pain or pressure in the chest, new confusion, bluish lips or face, gastrointestinal symptoms, etc.) will not be permitted to enter facility
 <p>Social Distancing</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reduced class sizes, Siblings grouped into same classes by level • Classrooms accessed through exterior doors only • Classroom groups kept separated, no movement of teachers or children between classrooms • Common areas closed (except playground), staggered playground times
 <p>PPE (Personal Protective Equipment)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Staff supplied with clean gloves and face masks • Staff trained on appropriate use of masks and social distancing when masks are not appropriate • Mask wearing mandatory for students over 3 and all staff
 <p>Hand Washing & Sanitizing</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Handwashing frequently throughout the day with soap and water for 20 seconds • Hand sanitizer dispensers installed at classroom entrances • Children and staff wash hands upon arrival and departure, before and after meals, after toileting, and after touching face
 <p>Intensified Cleaning & Sanitation</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Classroom surfaces and playground toys/equipment cleaned and sanitized after each use using EPA-registered disinfectant • High-touch surfaces (light switches and doorknobs) cleaned and sanitized daily • Toys prohibited that cannot be sanitized (pillows and stuffed animals)
 <p>Meals & Snacks</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mandatory use of disposable (or specific, easily sanitized) containers and utensils • No cloth backpacks or lunch boxes • Pre-cut fruits and vegetables provided for snack time by the school in disposable containers
 <p>Increased Air Flow</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Doors and windows kept open whenever possible • Activities moved outside whenever possible
 <p>COVID-19 Standardized Response Protocols</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sick individuals will be sent home, sick children isolated while awaiting pick up • Parent shall immediately notify Lakewood Montessori if child traveled outside of Idaho, had close contact with person suspected of having COVID-19, or tested positive for COVID-19. • Staff or children knowingly exposed to COVID-19 will be instructed to self-quarantine for 14 days from last exposure to infected person (or 14 days from end of end of infected household member’s isolation). • Staff and children exhibiting symptoms consistent with COVID-19 but are untested <u>or</u> who have tested positive for COVID-19 but are asymptomatic will not be permitted to return to the facility until fever free for 24 hours <u>and</u> symptoms improved <u>and</u> at least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared (unless severely ill, consult your doctor) • Lakewood will notify parents and co-workers if child or staff member tests positive for COVID-19 without disclosing infected person’s identity • Possible closure of facility for deep cleaning and disinfection if necessary
 <p>Suspended Tours</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All in-person tours suspended, virtual tours held after hours over video conferencing service
